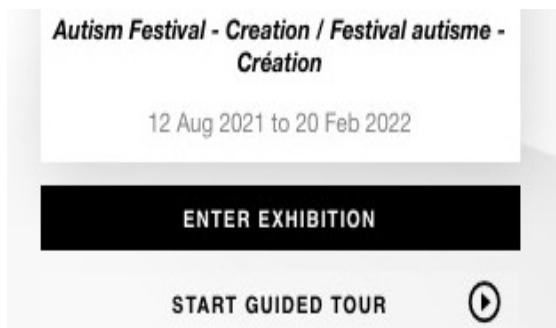

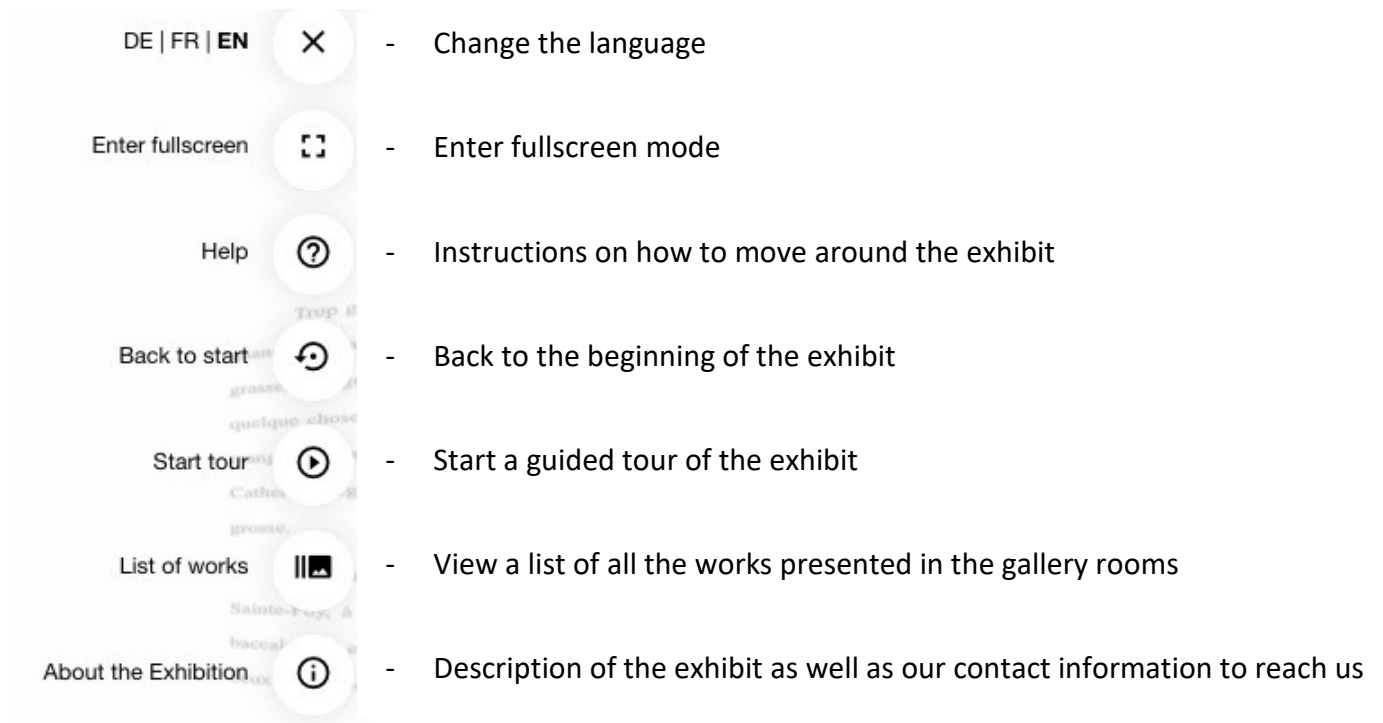
Our exhibit is presented on the Kunstmatrix platform. This brief guide will help you navigate the platform. Please access the exhibit [HERE](#).



Once you enter the exhibit, you can select one of two options:

1. Explore the gallery on your own (click “Enter Exhibition”)
2. Take a guided tour of the exhibit (click “Start Guided Tour”)

While in the exhibition, you can click on this button  at the top right corner of the screen for more options:



Exploring the gallery on your own (by clicking “Enter Exhibition”):

While visiting the exhibit, you can **click on each piece** of artwork in the gallery to examine it up close and view it in detail. Videos will begin playing once you click on them. Click “Exit detail view” (X) at the top right corner to zoom out of the piece and continue exploring the exhibit.

You can also click the **information button** (i) at the **top right corner of each piece** of artwork to view the **artist’s name** and their **description** of the artwork (when provided). Certain pieces will have a link at the bottom right corner that will allow you to view the entire piece.

Taking a guided tour of the exhibit (by clicking “Start Guided Tour”):


When you start a guided tour, you are automatically guided to visit every piece of art in the exhibit. You can **pause the tour** by clicking “pause tour” (⏸) at the top right corner. To **resume the tour**, you have to click on this button ≡ at the top right corner and then click “Start tour” to continue.

The **tour automatically pauses** when you:

- Play a video/audio clip
- Click the information button of a piece
- Click the link at the bottom right corner to view the entire video/audio clip or text

Simply follow the above step once you are ready to resume the tour.

Guest Book:

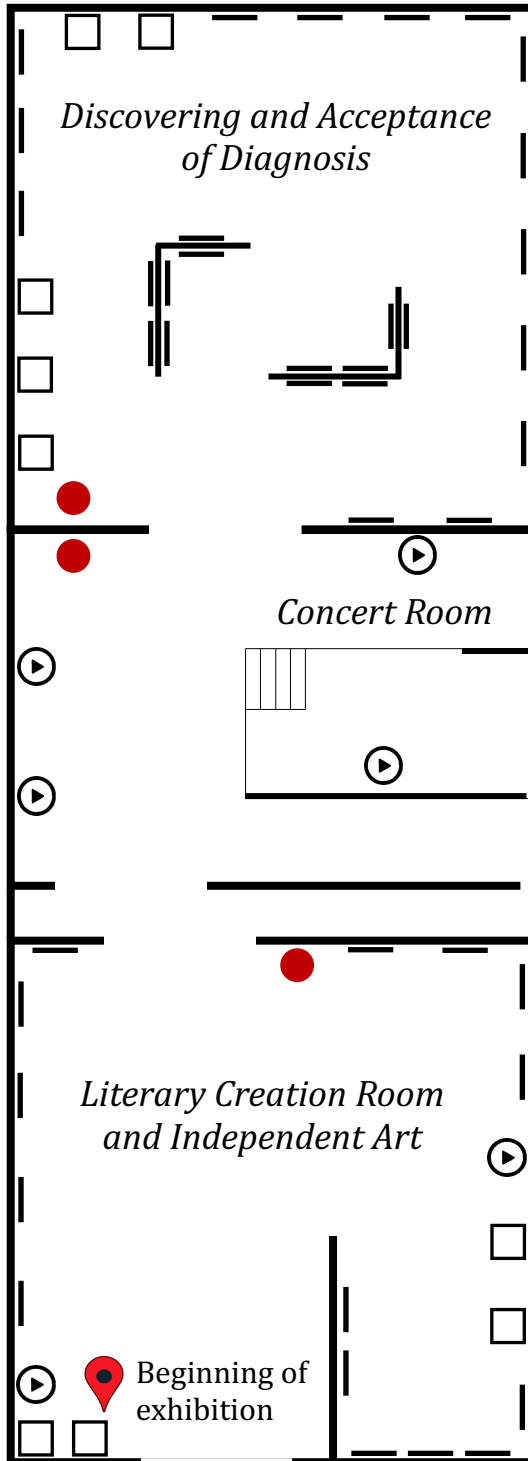
In each gallery room, you will find our **Guest Book** located near the door.  If you click on the Guest Book, you will notice a link at the bottom right that directs you to an external form where you can leave your comments. Clicking the information button (i) at the top right will also direct you to this form. The same form is available in all three rooms, you only need to leave comments once, if desired.
